Suggestion/Recommendation.

2. The formation of Alumni Cell was approved and committee suggested forming Alumni newsletter & Alumni meet for regular interaction with the Alumni.
3. It was suggested to encourage the students to excel not only in academics but also in other co-curricular activities like, sports, painting, singing, exhibitions etc.

7. It was suggested to implement the various targets to improve the research.


Suggestions from External Experts:


1. New courses like diploma, certification related to skill development should be included in the curriculum as per the need of societies.
